3 Identify ICD-10 code(s)

4 Identify date and time of collection for Nasopharyngeal swab

5 Select RIT panel based on medical necessity

6 Identify date and time of collection for Cary-Blair media

7 Select GIT panel based on medical necessity

8 Identify date and time of collection for Pharyngeal swab

9 Be sure to sign requisition before sending to lab
